As scientists we will:

- Identify and name parts of the human digestive system
- Know the functions of the organs in the human digestive system
- Identify and know the different types of teeth in humans
- Know the functions of different human teeth
- Use food chains to identify producers, predators and prey
- Construct food chains to identify producers, predators and prey

As authors we will:

- Write narrative poetry
- Writing letters.

As mathematicians we will:

- Understand place value in various forms including decimals and money
- Investigate time
- Learn about statistics
- Investigate properties of shape
- Develop our knowledge of position and direction
- Apply our knowledge to problem solving
- Develop our knowledge of the multiplication tables
- Discuss our learning with others using mathematical vocabulary
