As Computer technicians we will:

Learn new vocabulary related to spreadsheets; navigate around spreadsheets; enter data; use lock cell and move cell functions; perform calculations and use formulae within a spreadsheet.

As Designers we will:

Design and Make moving toys which are powered by water.

As Linguists we will:

Describe France's neighbours and positions of a variety of cities.
Learn the French names for famous French landmarks and how to describe what people do when they visit Paris.

As Historians we will:

Describe how some places are similar and others are different in relation to their human and physical features and discuss how they have changed over time.

As Authors we will:

Develop our knowledge of ratio, including using ratio language and symbols appropriately; calculating ratio and scale factors.

Participate in Whole Class Reading lessons.

As Citizens we will:

Learn about responding to pressure appropriately; explore bullying both in the real and digital world and learn how to stay safe, including drugs and alcohol education.
