Year 4 Summer Letter

Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to the summer term. We hope you all had a lovely break over the Easter holidays and we look forward to the final term of the year. Please find attached an overview of the main topics and subjects we will be covering this term.

This term, Mrs Clements and Mrs North continue to share the teaching in Year 4. Mrs Clements is responsible for the class on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday; Mrs North has responsibility on Thursdays and Fridays. Mrs Hare will teach the class on a Wednesday afternoon.

Mrs Butler will continue to support Year 4 on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday mornings and Mrs Jones will continue to support Year 4 on Thursday and Friday mornings.

We would like to take this opportunity to remind you of a few important details:

- ❖ **Uniform**—Please ensure that your child is in the correct uniform including black shoes. Please note that the wearing of nail varnish is not permitted in school. We are continuing the routine that the children come into school wearing their P.E kits on the days that they have P.E. It would be preferred that children with long hair wear it tied back. Year 4 PE lessons will take place on Mondays and Fridays. The children will be taking part in swimming lessons on Fridays during the summer term- more information about this will come out in a separate letter; until then the children will need to come to school in their P.E. kits on those days.

Kit List:

- Plain white t-shirt and plain dark shorts.
- A jumper
- Trainers or plimsolls

(A dark tracksuit may be worn in the colder months)

- ❖ **Homework** will be given out every Friday and will need to be handed in by the following Wednesday. The homework will continue as before: either a piece of English **or** maths will be set each week.

Maths will be an online activity. The children are continuing to enjoy practising their times tables on TTRockstars - the improvement in their times tables knowledge and fluency has been incredible and they are delighted to see the progress they are making; this will stand them in good stead for all of their maths work as times tables form a fundamental part of mathematics. The multiplication check will take place during June.

English will be a grammar based activity.

Reading - this should be on a daily basis. We are also encouraging children to write in their reading record whenever they read. Please ensure your child brings their book bags into school every day. We will continue to monitor reading through Accelerated Reader, where the children will take a quiz on each book they have read. Please ensure your child brings their book bags into school every day. Children are expected to change their own books during school time.

- ❖ Sun hats and cream are advisable for the summer term. Please remember to be sun safe as the weather improves!
- ❖ **Medical issues**- If your child needs medicine administering, please see the office and complete a form.
